

2023 Medicare Advantage \$0 Copay Vaccine List

In 2023, Part D Vaccines will be covered at a \$0 cost share when they are licensed by the FDA and recommended by the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) for use in adults.

- \$0 cost share only applies to people who have reached the age of 19 years or older
- \$0 cost share applies regardless of what formulary tier the vaccine is on
- \$0 cost share applies regardless of your benefit phase
